2            I. 2007, 128:2, relative to a prospective ban on the incidental combustion of untreated wood  
3 at municipal transfer stations.

4            II. 2010, 156, relative to a delayed effective date for 2007, 128:2 relative to a prospective ban  
5 on the incidental combustion of untreated wood at municipal transfer stations.

6            158:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
