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ANALYSIS

This bill allows a limited partnership to use the abbreviation “L.P.” in its name.

AN ACT                   relative to names of limited partnerships.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           60:1 Limited Partnerships; Name. Amend RSA 304-B:2, I(a) to read as follows:

2                   (a) Shall contain [~~without abbreviation~~] the words “limited partnership” ***or the***  
3 ***abbreviation “L.P.”, or similar abbreviation,*** as the last words of its name; ***and***

4           60:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
