AN ACT relative to names of limited partnerships.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 60:1 Limited Partnerships; Name. Amend RSA 304-B:2, I(a) to read as follows:

 (a) Shall contain [without abbreviation] the words "limited partnership" or the

 abbreviation "L.P.", or similar abbreviation, as the last words of its name; and

 60:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
