Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

4	2 Judicial Retirement Plan; Administration; Reference Deleted. Amend RSA 100-C:11, XI to
5	read as follows:
6	XI. [Following each calendar year, the board shall report to the fiscal committee of the
7	general court and the executive departments and administration committees of the senate and house
8	of representatives on the supplemental allowances paid pursuant to RSA 100-C:17.] The board shall
9	[also] annually provide copies of its annual report to the executive departments and administration
10	committees of the senate and house of representatives.

11 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
