STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT imposing an extended term of imprisonment for assault against a health care provider.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Extended Imprisonment; Assault on a Health Care Provider. Amend RSA 651:6, I(g) to read
2 as follows:

3 (g) Has knowingly committed or attempted to commit any of the crimes defined in
4 RSA 631 where he or she knows the victim was, at the time of the commission of the crime, a law
5 enforcement officer, a paid firefighter, volunteer firefighter, on-call firefighter, [ø] licensed
6 emergency medical care provider as defined in RSA 153-A:2, V, **or any person who is a direct**
7 **provider of health care including a physician, nurse, physician's assistant, or ancillary**
8 **personnel employed by or under the supervision of a physician, or any other person whose**
9 **primary function is to provide health care to another individual** acting in the line of duty;

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014.
