STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT relative to eligibility for in-state tuition rates at the university system of
New Hampshire.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 University System of New Hampshire; Authority of the Trustees. Amend RSA 187-A:16, XXIII
2 to read as follows:

3 XXIII. Require every student admitted after [~~December 31, 2012~~] **June 10, 2014** and
4 receiving the in-state rate of tuition to execute an affidavit attesting *that* he or she is a legal resident
5 of the United States, ***or require the student to file an application, a copy of which shall be***
6 ***furnished to the university system of New Hampshire, to legalize the student's status, or***
7 ***that the student will file such an application, a copy of which shall be furnished to the***
8 ***university system of New Hampshire, as soon as he or she is eligible. To be eligible for in-***
9 ***state tuition, a student who has filed or will fill such an application shall also meet the***
10 ***following requirements:***

11 ***(a) The student shall have graduated from an approved New Hampshire high***
12 ***school or earned the New Hampshire high school equivalency certificate.***

13 ***(b) The student shall have attended a high school in New Hampshire for 3 years***
14 ***prior to graduation or be domiciled in New Hampshire for 3 years prior to receiving a New***
15 ***Hampshire high school equivalency certificate.***

16 ***(c) The student shall have met all other criteria for in-state tuition status as***
17 ***established by the university system of New Hampshire board of trustees.***

18 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
