1 Rafting Prohibitions. Amend RSA 270:44 to read as follows:

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

2	270:44 Size of Rafts; Separation of Rafts and Single Boats. Except as otherwise provided in this
3	subdivision, no person shall, in a prohibited location or at a prohibited time:
4	I. Form or allow the boat which he or she is operating or in charge of to be a member of a
5	raft consisting of [3] 6 or more boats;
6	II. Form or allow the boat which he or she is operating or in charge of to be a member of a
7	raft if any part of such raft is:
8	(a) Less than $[50]$ 25 feet from any other raft; or
9	(b) Less than $[50]$ 25 feet from any occupied single boat which is stationary upon the
10	waters of the same lake or pond.
11	III. Anchor a single boat and cause it to remain stationary upon the waters of a lake or pond
12	other than momentarily if any part of such boat is:
13	(a) Less than $[50]$ 25 feet away from any raft; or
14	(b) Less than 25 feet away from any other single boat which is stationary upon the
15	waters of such lake or pond.
