Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Moratorium on Applications for Certificates for Electric Transmission Facilities. All site 2 evaluation committee proceedings on pending applications for certificates for any electric 3 transmission facility not eligible for regional cost allocation, for either local or regional transmission 4 tariffs, by ISO-New England, shall be stayed for one year from the effective date of this section. No 5 new application for such electric transmission facility shall be accepted for filing by the site 6 evaluation committee for one year following the effective date of this section. 7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
