HOUSE BILL            **1109**

AN ACT                relative to providing notice to abutters of a petitioned warrant article to  
discontinue a class VI road.

SPONSORS:            Rep. Fields, Belk 4; Rep. Raymond, Belk 4

COMMITTEE:          Municipal and County Government

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill requires petitioners to bear the cost of notice when a petitioned warrant article calls for the discontinuance of a class VI highway.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1 41:1 Power to Discontinue Highway; Notice. Amend RSA 231:43, II to read as follows:

2 II. ***The selectmen shall give*** written notice [~~shall be given~~] ***by verified mail, as defined***  
3 ***in RSA 451-C:1, VII***, to all owners of property abutting such highway, at least 14 days prior to the  
4 vote of the town. ***In the case of a petitioned warrant article calling for discontinuance of a***  
5 ***class VI highway, the petitioners shall bear the cost of notice.***

6 41:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
