### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT relative to the penalty for sales chasing by certified assessors.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

9	penalties associated with knowingly committing or being party to sales chasing.
