STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen*

AN ACT                   relative to the membership of the advanced manufacturing education advisory council.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           85:1 New Subparagraph; Advanced Manufacturing Education Advisory Council. Amend RSA  
2 188-E:22, I by inserting after subparagraph (i) the following new subparagraph:

3                   (j) One member who is employed as a secondary school counselor or a state guidance  
4 director, appointed by the governor.

5           85:2 Advanced Manufacturing Education Advisory Council. Amend RSA 188-E:22, II(a) to read  
6 as follows:

7                   (a) The term of office for each member appointed under subparagraphs I(g), I(h), ~~and~~  
8 I(i), **and I(j)** shall be 3 years, or until a successor is appointed and qualified in the case of a vacancy.  
9 The term of office for all other members shall be coterminous with the term of office for the position  
10 that qualifies that member to serve on the advisory council. A vacancy shall be filled in the same  
11 manner, but only for the unexpired term.

12           85:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
