Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened: 1 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study a alternative public $\mathbf{2}$ employee retirement plans. 3 2 Membership and Compensation. I. The members of the committee shall be as follows: 4 $\mathbf{5}$ (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house 6 of representatives. $\overline{7}$ (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate. 8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to 9 the duties of the committee. 10 3 Duties. The committee shall study alternative public employee retirement plans. The committee shall examine public employee retirement systems adopted or proposed in other 11 12jurisdictions including cash balance plans. 134 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from 14among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this 1516section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum. 175 Reports. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house 18 19clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library in an interim report on or before 20November 1, 2014 and in a final report on or before November 1, 2015. 216 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
