Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- Filling of Vacancies; Other Offices; Appointment of Immediate Family Members Prohibited.
 Amend RSA 669:75 to read as follows:
- 3 669:75 Vacancies in Other Offices. Vacancies in the offices of constable, sewer commissioner,

4 town assessor, overseers of public welfare, library trustee, and any other optional offices where no

5 other method of filling a vacancy shall be provided by vote of the town shall be filled by appointment

- 6 made by the board of selectmen. No such vacancy shall be filled by an immediate family
- 7 member of any selectman.
- 8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
