AN ACT permitting municipalities to reimburse persons who assist applicants in obtaining social security benefits.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Section; Aid to Assisted Persons; Liability for Support and Recovery Over; Payment for 2 Representation Before Social Security Administration. Amend RSA 165 by inserting after section 3 20-c the following new section: 4 165:20-d Payment for Representation Before Social Security Administration. If a city or town 5 seeks reimbursement of local assistance from a person's subsequent supplemental security income 6 (SSI) award or social security disability insurance (SSDI) award, the city or town may use a portion 7 of the reimbursement to pay the person's representative before the Commissioner of Social Security, 8 provided that the payment is approved by the Social Security Administration pursuant to 20 9 U.S.C.A. section 406. 10
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
