Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; School Boards; Policy on Advertising. Amend RSA 189 by inserting after section

2 15-a the following new section:

3 189:15-b Policy on Advertising. A school board may develop and implement a policy permitting

4 commercial advertising to be posted on school district property, including real property of the school

5 district, school busses, or other school district vehicles.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
