AN ACT                   relative to enforcement of labor laws by the department of labor.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           49:1 Labor Commissioner; Imposition of Civil Penalties. Amend RSA 273:11-a, I to read as  
2 follows:

3           I. In addition to any criminal penalty provided under this [~~chapter~~] **title**, the commissioner  
4 may, after hearing, impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$2,500, as determined by the commissioner,  
5 for any violation of [~~any of~~] the provisions of [~~this chapter~~], or [~~of~~] any rule adopted pursuant to, this  
6 [~~chapter~~] **title, except RSA 273-A, RSA 273-C, and RSA 282-A**. All moneys collected under this  
7 section shall be deposited in the general fund.

8           49:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
