AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill adds certain contests and sweepstakes that are conducted in connection with the marketing or promotion of insurance products to the exceptions to the anti-rebating law.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	173:1 Anti-Rebating; Exceptions. Amend RSA 402:41, I(f) to read as follows:
2	(f) Contests, sweepstakes, raffles, or drawings, conducted in connection with the
3	marketing or promotion of insurance products, if:
4	(1) The total prize value for all <i>contests</i> , <i>sweepstakes</i> , raffles, or drawings in a 12-
5	month period [de] does not exceed \$1,000 provided, however, that this subparagraph shall not
6	apply to insurer contests, sweepstakes, raffles, or drawings;
7	(2) There is no participation cost to entrants; and
8	(3) The <i>contest</i> , <i>sweepstakes</i> , raffle, <i>or drawing</i> is open to consumers who are no
9	policyholders and the consumer is not required to purchase a policy in order to be eligible to enter the
10	contest, sweepstakes, raffle, or drawing or receive a [raffle] prize.
