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ANALYSIS

This bill repeals various statutory changes made by chapter 249 of the 2013 regular legislative session, related to placement in shelter care facilities and at the youth development center.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 Repeal. The following are repealed:
- 2           I. RSA 169-B:2, XV, relative to the definition of shelter care facility.
- 3           II. RSA 169-D:2, XIV, relative to the definition of shelter care facility.
- 4           III. RSA 621:1, III, relative to placement in the least restrictive environment.
- 5           IV. RSA 621:19, I-a, relative to release and discharge from the youth development center.
- 6           V. RSA 169-D:31, relative to closure and review of disposition in delinquency cases.
- 7           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
