STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to driving on limited access highways.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Driving on Divided Ways; Use of Left Lane of Limited Access Highways.
 2 Amend RSA 265:26 by inserting after paragraph I the following new paragraph:
 3 I-a. A vehicle shall not be driven in the left lane of any limited access highway of 3 lanes or
 4 more with a posted speed limit of at least 65 miles per hour, except in overtaking a slower vehicle, in
 5 yielding to traffic coming onto such highway, or when traffic conditions exist which would prohibit
 6 safe use of the right or center lanes.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
