AN ACT relative to grocery sales by stores licensed to sell alcoholic beverages.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Alcoholic Beverages; Definitions. Amend RSA 175:1, XXXVI to read as follows:
2	XXXVI. "Grocery or convenience store" means any retail establishment where groceries are
3	regularly and customarily sold for consumption off premises. [Such establishment shall have and
4	maintain groceries which are readily available to the public, the wholesale value of which shall not
5	be less than \$3,000, exclusive of eigarettes, magazines, newspapers, wine and beverages. Such
6	groceries shall be representative of grocery items commonly found in such stores.]
7	2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
