AN ACT relative to youth safety regarding mooring and rafting of boats at or near youth camps.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Mooring or Rafting of Boats At or Near Youth Camps Prohibited. Amend
 2 RSA 270:44 by inserting after paragraph III the following new paragraph:
 3 IV. Form or allow the boat that he or she is operating to be a member of a raft, or moored to
 4 a single mooring, that is within 150 feet of children swimming or other organized waterfront
 5 activities, at a recreation camp or youth skill camp, as defined in RSA 485-A:23.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
