STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen*

AN ACT                    requiring bottled water labels to indicate the source of water.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1    New Section; Sanitary Production and Distribution of Food; Manufacture and Sale of  
2    Beverages; Bottled Water Labels. Amend RSA 143 by inserting after section 16 the following new  
3    section:

4            143:16-a Bottled Water Labels. All bottles, packages, or containers of bottled water sold, offered  
5    for sale, or bottled in this state shall have a label that clearly indicates the specific location from  
6    which the water was obtained, including the address of a water purveyor, artesian or driven well,  
7    spring, or other point of origin.

8            2    Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
