STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT requiring bottled water labels to indicate the source of water.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 New Section; Sanitary Production and Distribution of Food; Manufacture and Sale of Beverages; Bottled Water Labels. Amend RSA 143 by inserting after section 16 the following new 2 3 section: 143:16-a Bottled Water Labels. All bottles, packages, or containers of bottled water sold, offered 4 5 for sale, or bottled in this state shall have a label that clearly indicates the specific location from 6 which the water was obtained, including the address of a water purveyor, artesian or driven well, 7 spring, or other point of origin. 8

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
