AN ACT relative to additional criteria for review of chartered public school applications. Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened: New Subparagraphs; Application Requirements for Chartered Public Schools. 1 Amend RSA 194-B:3, II by inserting after subparagraph (dd) the following new subparagraphs: (ee) A plan requiring the measurement of student learning in a subject where skills and knowledge, determined by the board, to be necessary for success in both college and careers upon 4graduation.

6 (ff) If the proposed school will offer academic programs to student populations in 7geographic areas where chartered public schools are not present or reasonably accessible.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
