Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Solid Waste Disposal; Rulemaking; Florescent Lamps. Amend RSA 147-A:3, IV to read a
2	follows:
3	IV. The storage, treatment, containerization, transportation, and disposal of hazardous
4	wastes; provided, however, that:
5	(a) No rule shall be adopted or applied so as to impose any transporter permitting
6	program or requirement.
7	(b) No rule shall be adopted or applied that would require a transfer station to
8	store florescent lamps in closed containers if such lamps are stored for a period of less than
9	one week.

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
