1	1 Highway Surveillance. Amend	RSA 236:130 to read as follows:	
2	236:130 Highway Surveillance Prohibited.		
3	I. In this subdivision, "sur	veillance" means the act of determining the ownership or	
4	<i>location</i> of a motor vehicle or the identity of a motor vehicle's occupants on the public ways of the		
5	state or its political subdivisions through the use of a camera or other imaging device or any other		
6	device, including but not limited to a transponder, cellular telephone, global positioning satellite, or		
7	radio frequency identification device, that by itself or in conjunction with other devices or		
8	information can be used to determine the ownership of a motor vehicle or the identity of a motor		
9	vehicle' s occupants.	vehicle's occupants.	
10	II. Neither the state of New	Hampshire [nor], its political subdivisions, nor any person	
11	shall engage in surveillance on any pu	blic ways of the state or its political subdivisions.	
12	III. The prohibition set forth i	n paragraph II shall not apply where surveillance:	
13	(a) Is specifically authoriz	ed by statute;	
14	(b) Is undertaken on a ca	ase-by-case basis in the investigation of a particular violation,	
15	misdemeanor, or felony;		
16	(c) Is undertaken to produ	ce images or data that:	
17	(1) Are viewed only a	t the transportation management center of the department of	
18	transportation in connection with a pa	rticular incident occurring on a public way; and	
19	(2) Are not recorded;		
20	(d) Is incidental to the m	onitoring of a building or other structure [under the control of	
21	the state or a political subdivision of t	he state];	
22	(e) Is undertaken for purp	oses of operation of the toll collection system; or	
23	(f) Is undertaken for the	security of the following bridges and approach structures: I-95	
24	Piscataqua River Bridge, Sarah Mild	red Long Bridge, and the Memorial Bridge, all in Portsmouth,	
25	provided that no data, including	provided that no data, including images, collected through such surveillance shall be	
26	transferred to any other person or retained for more than 30 days except on a case-by-case		
27	basis in the investigation of a particular violation, misdemeanor, or felony.		
28	IV. Nothing in this section	shall prevent the creation, transmission, or recording of any	
29	images or data which cannot, by enha	ncement, manipulation, or otherwise, be used for surveillance.	
30	V. Any person violating the pr	covisions of this section shall be guilty of a violation if a natural	
31	person, or guilty of a misdemeanor if a	iny other person.	

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1 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
