STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the definition of "party" for election purposes.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Elections; Definitions; Party. Amend RSA 652:11 to read as follows:
- 2 652:11 Party. "Party" shall mean any political organization which at the preceding state general
- 3 election received at least [4] 3 percent of the total number of votes cast for any one of the following:
- 4 the office of governor or the offices of United States Senators.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
