Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Landlord's Agent Required. Amend RSA 540:1-b by inserting after 2 paragraph IV the following new paragraph:
- V. A municipality may, pursuant to its bylaws or ordinances, establish and collect a \$500 fine for the failure of an owner of restricted property to comply with the requirements of this section.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
