STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT excluding firearms records from public records subject to disclosure under the
right-to-know law.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Right-to-Know; Firearms Records Exempted. Amend RSA 91-A:5 by
2 inserting after paragraph IX the following new paragraph:

3 X. Records relating to firearms licenses, permits, applications, or other documents reflecting
4 the issuance or denial of a license or permit, except by the person holding the license, permit,
5 application, or other document or upon the request of persons acting in their governmental capacity
6 for purposes of the administration of justice.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
