HOUSE BILL            ***1391***

AN ACT                relative to blood drawn from patients with hemochromatosis.

SPONSORS:            Rep. Weyler, Rock 13

COMMITTEE:          Health, Human Services and Elderly Affairs

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ANALYSIS

This bill requires licensed health care facilities which accept blood donations to seek a waiver from the federal Food and Drug Administration to enable the facility to use blood drawn from certain patients.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 New Section; Facilities Accepting Blood Donations. Amend RSA 151 by inserting after section
- 2 12-b the following new section:
- 3           151:12-c Facilities Accepting Blood Donations Required to Seek Waiver. Facilities licensed
- 4 pursuant to this chapter which accept blood donations shall seek a waiver from the federal Food and
- 5 Drug Administration permitting them to use blood drawn from hemochromatosis patients.
- 6           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
