Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Subparagraph; Rulemaking; Increase Over Certain Percentage Prohibited by Rule.
- 2 Amend RSA 541-A:22, III by inserting after subparagraph (h) the following new subparagraph:
- 3 (i) Increase any fee by more than 20 percent.
- 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
