Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Prohibited Coercion of Political Contributions; Public Employees. Amend RSA 664:4-a, I to

- read as follows:

 I. No person shall knowingly coerce, or attempt to coerce, any [elassified state] public

 employee to give or withhold a contribution to any political campaign or political committee, or to

 any candidate, party, or cause, for the purpose of promoting the success or defeat of any candidate or

 political party.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
