#### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT requiring college identification cards to indicate whether the student is an in-state or out-of-state student.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

## HB 1505-FN - FISCAL NOTE

AN ACT

requiring college identification cards to indicate whether the student is an in-state or out-of-state student.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The University System of New Hampshire states this bill, <u>as introduced</u>, will increase state expenditures by \$12,000 in FY 2014. There will be no impact on state revenue, or county and local revenues or expenditures.

## **METHODOLOGY:**

The University System of New Hampshire states this bill would require all student identification cards to indicate whether the student is an "in-state" or "out-of-state" student. The System states it would be required to modify its identification card software and estimates this could cost approximately \$3,000 for each of its four institutions for a total cost of \$12,000.

The Community College System of New Hampshire states this bill will have no impact on its revenues or expenditures.
