Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Committee to Study the Resolution of Barriers to the Use of Telehealth Technology in New Hampshire; Report Date Extended. Amend 2013, 112:5 to read as follows:

  112:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, [2013] 2014.
  - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
