HOUSE BILL ***1614***

AN ACT relative to pharmacy benefit cards.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires health benefit plans issuing pharmacy benefit cards to include the insurance department's consumer hotline telephone number.

This bill is a result of 2013, 182, the committee to study the regulation of pharmacy benefits managers.

- 4 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
