HOUSE BILL 1632

AN ACT relative to child support orders for children with disabilities.

SPONSORS: Rep. Bouchard, Merr 18; Rep. Henle, Merr 12

COMMITTEE: Children and Family Law

ANALYSIS

This bill clarifies that no child support order for a child with disabilities that takes effect after July 9, 2013 may continue after the child reaches 21 years of age. The bill also permits the court to reinstate a child support order for a child with disabilities that was modified or vacated between July 9, 2013 and the effective date of this act.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to child support orders for children with disabilities.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	225:1 Parental Rights and Responsibilities; Duration of Support for Children with Disabilities
2	Amend RSA 461-A:14, IV to read as follows:
3	IV. The amount of a child support obligation shall remain as stated in the order until the
4	dependent child for whom support is ordered completes his or her high school education or reaches
5	the age of 18 years, whichever is later, or marries, or becomes a member of the armed services, as
6	which time the child support obligation, including all educational support obligations, terminates
7	without further legal action. If the parties have a child with disabilities, the court may initiate or
8	continue the child support obligation after the child reaches the age of 18. No child support order for
9	a child with disabilities which becomes effective after July 9, 2013 may continue after the child
10	reaches age 21.
11	225:2 Modification of Child Support Orders for Children with Disabilities. The court may
12	reinstate a child support order for a child with disabilities which was in effect on July 9, 2013 and
13	modified or vacated between July 9, 2013 and the effective date of this act.
14	225:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
