SENATE BILL **29**

AN ACT relative to the motorist service signing program.

SPONSORS: Sen. Rausch, Dist 19

COMMITTEE: Transportation

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Exempts the motorist service signing program from rulemaking since the program is controlled by federal regulations.

II. Requires rulemaking for the rental fee setting process if the commissioner of transportation sets the fee.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT relative to the motorist service signing program.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Motorist Service Signing Program. RSA 230:49, II is repealed and reenacted to read as
2 follows:

3 II. The sign program permitted under paragraph I is controlled by federal regulations and is
4 therefore exempt from rulemaking. The signs may be rented for a fee established by the
5 commissioner of transportation or rented through third party contractors. If the commissioner sets
6 the fee, rulemaking is required for the fee setting process.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
