Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

RSA 151:35 is repealed and reenacted to read as 3 follows: 151:35 Limitation. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, hospitals or 4 5 ambulatory surgical facilities may provide, and the department may collect under this subdivision, 6 any data or patient identifiers as set forth in the protocols and specifications published and 7 periodically amended by the National Healthcare Safety Network; provided that an individual 8 patient's name, street address, city or town, telephone number, and social security number shall not 9 be included in any data collected.
