STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT relative to library funds.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Library Trustees; Funds. Amend RSA 202-A:11, III to read as follows:
2 III. Expend all moneys raised and appropriated by the town or city for library purposes and
3 shall direct that such moneys be paid over by the town or city treasurer pursuant to a payment
4 schedule as agreed to by the library trustees and the selectmen or city council. All money received
5 from fines and payments for lost or damaged books or for the support of a library in another city or
6 town under contract to furnish library service to such town or city, shall be used for general repairs
7 and upgrading, and for the purchase of books, supplies and income-generating equipment, shall be
8 held in a nonlapsing [~~separate~~] fund and shall be in addition to the appropriation;
9 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
