AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill authorizes the commissioner of the department of administrative services to administer the health benefits of certain retirees of the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire who were in the plan as of July 1, 2013.

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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT allowing the commissioner of administrative services to administer the health benefits of certain retirees of the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

318:1 State Employees Group Insurance; Administration. Amend RSA 21-I:27 to read as

2 follows:

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3 21-I:27 Administration.

I. Administration of the state employees permanent group life and state employees and 4 $\mathbf{5}$ retirees group hospitalization, hospital medical care, surgical care and other medical and surgical 6 insurance benefits shall be the responsibility of the commissioner of administrative services. If the 7 commissioner of administrative services concludes that inclusion of the university system of 8 New Hampshire in the health plan would best serve the interests of the state employees and the 9 state of New Hampshire, then the commissioner shall, with the consent of the university system 10board of trustees, administer the health benefits of the university system of New Hampshire 11 employees as set forth in this subdivision.

12II. The commissioner may administer the health benefits of the employees of the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, Inc., SEIU, Local 1984, [AFL-CIO, CLC,], and certain 1314retirees of the Association who were in the plan as of July 1, 2013, as set forth in this 15subdivision until such time as the commissioner concludes that the inclusion of the State Employees' 16Association *employees and certain retirees* does not serve the interests of the state employees and the state of New Hampshire. The State Employees' Association shall timely pay to the 1718department of administrative services the cost of the premium for its participating 19employees and retirees in the plan.

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318:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
