AN ACT                   relative to notifying a UOCAVA voter of an invalid absentee ballot application.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           113:1 UOCAVA Voters; Invalid Application. Amend RSA 657:19, X to read as follows:

2           X. A town or city clerk who finds an absentee ballot application invalid shall provide the  
3 UOCAVA voter the reason it is invalid within 7 days *in accordance with the procedures in*  
4 ***RSA 657:16.***

5           113:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
