Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Franchises; Administration by Municipality. RSA 53-C:3-b is repealed and reenacted to read
<b>2</b>	as follows:
3	53-C:3-b Franchises; Nonexclusive.
4	I. All franchises shall be nonexclusive.
<b>5</b>	II. All cable service franchises in existence on May 1, 1989, shall remain in full force and
6	effect according to their existing terms.
7	2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
