SENATE BILL **349**

AN ACT relative to the election of delegates to state party conventions.

SPONSORS: Sen. Rausch, Dist 19; Sen. Carson, Dist 14; Rep. G. Chandler, Carr 1

COMMITTEE: Public and Municipal Affairs

ANALYSIS

This bill repeals provisions that would have eliminated, as of January 1, 2015, the requirement that delegates to state party conventions have to be elected in accordance with districts established by statute.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT relative to the election of delegates to state party conventions.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 202:1 Repeal. 2012, 63:2 and 63:3, relative to repealing the apportionment of delegates to state
2 party conventions, is repealed.

3 202:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
