This bill changes the time of waiver applicability, the requirement to purchase liability, general and pollution, insurance, and the practice of insurance procurement with regard to facilities for the Winnepesaukee River basin control.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen

AN ACT relative to insurance coverage for facilities for the Winnepesaukee River basin control.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 146:1 Insurance; Winnepesaukee River Basin Control. RSA 485-A:53 is repealed and reenacted
2 to read as follows:

3 485-A:53 Insurance. The department shall purchase insurance, including extended coverage
4 insurance, to protect the pollution control facilities administered under this subdivision against fire,
5 vandalism, and malicious mischief. The cost of the insurance shall be included in the user fee. If the
6 department determines that any of the foregoing insurance is unavailable or uneconomical, it may
7 request the governor and council to waive the provisions of this section for the term of the coverage.
8 Nothing in this section shall be construed as a waiver of the state's sovereign immunity regardless of
9 the department's ability to procure the types of insurance described in this section.

10 146:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
