AN ACT establishing a committee to study how to regulate and control synthetic drugs in New Hampshire.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	207:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study how to regulate and
2	control synthetic drugs in New Hampshire.
3	207:2 Membership and Compensation.
4	I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:
5	(a) One member of the senate, appointed by the senate president.
6	(b) Three members of the house of representatives, one of whom shall be from the
7	criminal justice and public safety committee, and 2 of whom shall be from the health, human
8	services and elderly affairs committee, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.
9	II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
10	the duties of the committee.
11	207:3 Duties.
12	I. The committee shall study:
13	(a) What substances are within the definition of synthetic drugs.
14	(b) The scope of the problem of synthetic drugs in New Hampshire.
15	(c) Federal regulation of synthetic drugs.
16	(d) Current efforts in New Hampshire to regulate and control synthetic drugs, including
17	local ordinances.
18	(e) Ongoing efforts in other jurisdictions to regulate and control synthetic drugs.
19	(f) Any model legislation related to the regulation and control of synthetic drugs,
20	including proposals from the National Alliance of State Model Drug Laws.
21	(g) Legislation to address the problem of synthetic drugs in New Hampshire, including
22	appropriate sanctions for the manufacture, sale, distribution, and use of synthetic drugs.
23	(h) Any other issue that the committee deems relevant to the purpose of this study.
24	II. The committee may solicit testimony from any person or organization with information or
25	expertise which the committee deems relevant to the object of this study.
26	207:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson
27	from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the senate member.

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- 1 The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section.
- 2 Two members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.
- 3 207:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
- 4 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
- 5 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2014.

6 207:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
