STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fourteen*

AN ACT                   relative to information provided to electric utility customers.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           149:1 Public Utilities Commission; Meeting and Report.

2           I. The public utilities commission shall convene the electric utilities within 30 days of the  
3 effective date of this act to determine the most effective and appropriate means to provide customers  
4 with information explaining the system benefits charge, the renewable portfolio standard  
5 requirements, and the regional greenhouse gas initiative. The commission shall work with the  
6 utilities to determine the best way to help customers understand the administration of these  
7 programs.

8           II. The commission shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the speaker  
9 of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the energy and natural resources  
10 committee, the science, technology and energy committee, the house clerk, the senate clerk, the  
11 governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2014.

12           149:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
