AN ACT relative to providers prescribing cannabis for therapeutic purposes.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

Use of Cannabis for Therapeutic Purposes; Definition of "Provider." Amend RSA 126-X:1,
VII(a) to read as follows:

3 VII.(a) "Provider" means a physician licensed to prescribe drugs to humans under RSA 329

4 and who possesses certification from the United States Drug Enforcement Administration to

5 prescribe controlled substances. "Provider" shall also mean an advanced practice registered nurse

- 6 licensed pursuant to RSA 326-B:18 and a physician assistant licensed under RSA 328-D.
- 7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
