HOUSE BILL ***139-FN***

AN ACT relative to an emergency exception under the New Hampshire retirement system
for certain part-time employment.

SPONSORS: Rep. Ratzki, Merr 1

COMMITTEE: Executive Departments and Administration

ANALYSIS

This bill modifies the limitations on part-time employment under the New Hampshire retirement system during an emergency.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to an emergency exception under the New Hampshire retirement system
for certain part-time employment.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Hampshire Retirement System; Certain Part-Time Employment; Emergency Exception.

2 Amend RSA 100-A:7-b to read as follows:

3 100-A:7-b Certain Part-Time Employment; Emergency Exception. The hourly limitations on
4 part-time employment as defined in RSA 100-A:1, XXXIV shall be [~~modified~~] **suspended** for retired
5 members who exceed the 32-hour limit while providing assistance during an emergency under this
6 section. While providing assistance during an emergency under this section, a retired member may
7 exceed the 32-hour limit in a calendar week [~~provided that the member has not exceeded 1300 hours~~
8 ~~in the current calendar year~~]. For purposes of this section, an emergency includes any event
9 declared by the governor, **activities performed for a local organization for emergency**
10 **management under RSA 21-P:39**, or while working under the direction of the director of the
11 division of forests and lands during woodland fire control.

12 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

HB 139-FN - FISCAL NOTE

AN ACT relative to an emergency exception under the New Hampshire retirement system
for certain part-time employment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The New Hampshire Retirement System states this bill, **as introduced**, will have no impact on state, county, or local revenue and expenditures.

METHODOLOGY:

The New Hampshire Retirement System states this bill adds “activities performed for a local organization for emergency management under RSA 21-P:39” to the list of activities exempt from the 32-hour limitation on part-time employment. The System states that such emergencies appear to be covered under language already included in RSA 100-A:7-b; as such, the System states the bill will have no fiscal impact.
