Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Use of Cannabis for Therapeutic Purposes; Registry Identification Cards. The department of

2 health and human services shall begin processing applications for registry identification cards, as

3 required under RSA 126-X:4, no later than July 25, 2015.

4 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
