AN ACT relative to table stakes poker.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

160:1 Table Stakes Poker. Amend RSA 287-D:16 to read as follows: 1 2 287-D:16 No single wager by a player, on any game of chance, shall exceed the amount of \$4. 3 Provided, however, that in games of poker where the chips have monetary value, play may be conducted under "table stakes" rules where the amount of blinds, antes, and any other 4 type of forced bet shall not exceed \$4 per player but the amount wagered by a player during 5 6 the play of a hand shall not be limited except by the amount of chips the player has in his 7 or her possession on the table. In any such "table stakes" game, the amount of chips a player may purchase during the course of play in said game shall be no greater in value 8 9 than \$150. 160:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, at 12:01 a.m. 10 11
